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### Breitling Navitimer 1 B01 Chronograph 43 Swissair Edition Watch

NEW In 2019, Breitling replica swiss watches released the new Navitimer with some interesting influences and aesthetic changes. The new Breitling Navitimer 1 B01 Chronograph 43 Swissair Edition appears to be the first in the aviation series that Breitling promises to expand. Last year, Breitling took a bold move and released the "updated" Navitimer 8 series for a comprehensive evaluation. Later, they released a more modern B01 design with the classic Navitimer design, and if foreseeable, the controversy was much smaller. Now, with a lot to learn from the early days of Navitimer and the airlines of that era, this new watch has been influenced by Breitling's claim to be "the most iconic airline at the time", starting with the Swiss Air edition.

This is an interesting move for Breitling, and it seems to be the beginning of a new navigator. This Swissair version appears to be the cornerstone of Breitling's claim to be the "capsule series". Considering the brand's Swiss character and Swiss Air's "cooperation" previously represented only by the watch name and case, I think this is appropriate. Aircraft pointed second hand. This watch has a unique look, and even if it doesn't seem to be racing style, I think it's impossible when you use the red and black color scheme.[www.chrono36.com](http://www.chrono36.com)

Breitling Navitimer 1 B01 Chronograph 43 Swissair Edition has the same functions as the standard Navitimer. In addition to the red color scheme, there are slide rule bezels and panda watch plate registers, and the "Swissair" logo on the sapphire caseback. Strangely, Breitling used the modern logo of Swissair (after bankruptcy in 2002), although it was significantly affected in the 1950s and 1960s (though I would say it was even more so in the 1970s). In any case, more modern brands are different from many Pan American brands we have seen in the industry over the years. Unlike TAG Heuer x Monaco Gulf, Breitling does not have a particularly long history in this airline, so I will show great interest in its fares.

Anyway, this is a cool watch. I couldn't help but see the influence of the car in this watch-I immediately remembered the Panda dial of Chopard Mille Miglia-not exactly in line with the typical aviation inspired watch. What I see here is a unique color scheme, regardless of brand. Although Swissair is only the first in the series, this is a good start to the interesting direction the brand has taken.
